Reports

- 1. The members present unanimously confirmed the minutes of the previous meeting.
- 2. Considering the demand of local and student community (as most students of our institution are from the farming community and have to contribute labour and time in cultivation as well as other related activities at home), and to immediately address the issue regarding the shortage of classrooms raised in previous meeting by members present and keeping in mind the fact that construction of new classrooms is a time taking activity: the members present recommend the extension of day session in order to address the demand of the local and student community as well as the concerns of college faculty members at the earliest.
- The members recommend the authorities to forward the applications of four S.A.C.T s namely:
 - (e) Ms. SujataGoswami, Department of Geography
 - (f) Mr. Sanjay Doloi, Department of Physical Education
 - (g) Mr. SwarupSamanta, Department of Political Science
 - (h) Ms. AnweshaRai, Department of Philosophy to concerned authorities so that they can avail their ten-year benefit.



- 4. As there are no-full time faculty members in the Department of Sanskrit and Santali, the committee recommends to take necessary measures for the creation of full-time faculty post in the mentioned departments.
- 5. The members put forth a long standing demand of the college community i.e., the need for a college playground and requested the authorities to take necessary action in the said matter as such a facility is crucial for all round development of the student community and sports related activities can be conducted at ease and on regular intervals in the college premises.
- 6. The need for establishing a Competitive Exam Coaching Centre (W.B.C.S & other competitive exams) in the college was discussed. Such ventures will play an important role as students/ aspirants have difficulty in accessing facilities that are available in the city which is about 45 kilometers away.
- 7. The members proposed the adaptation of a village, namely Belaboni to carry out activities that will support the marginalized & underprivileged people of the said village. Other committees and departments are suggested to conduct social outreach programmes so that the college can directly play an important role in overall improvement of surrounding areas.
- 8. Members present pointed out the dire and immediate need to enrich the academic atmosphere of the college not only through community engagement but also through academic activities like Seminars and Conferences that are interdisciplinary in nature in keeping with the changing nature of education as pointed out by various UGC circulars and updates.
- 9. The members brought to attention the role endowment funds may play in encouraging students to perform better in academics as well as in other related activities and recommended the enhancement of existing endowment funds by actively seeking financial assistance from the stakeholders of the college and local community.
- 10. The members observed that the college Library needs more hands for better and smooth functioning of existing facilities. Drawing the attention of the college authorities towards this matter the committee requests to take necessary steps to address the issue.

Reports

- 1. The members present unanimously confirmed the minutes of the previous meeting.
- 2. IQAC forwarded the application of Dr. Tirtha Mondal, Assistant Professor in the Department of Physical Education for pursuing the Short-Term Course of from 19.07.2022 to 25.07.2022.
- 3. IQAC forwarded the application of Dr. Mamoni Mahata, Assistant Professor in the Dept. of Bengali, for pursuing the Refresher course of from 11.08.2022 to 26.08.2022.
- 4. The student feedback report for 2021-2022 shows that the majority of students answered positively (Excellent and Good) to practically every topic. Over 60% of students are highly satisfied (Excellent) with matters such as Teachers' Availability, Personal Interaction with Teachers outside of Class Hours, Scholarship opportunities, Drinking Water quality, and Discipline. 70% of students rated aspects such as Routine, Remedial Coaching, Reprography/Document Copying Facility, Staff Attitude, General Office-College Affairs, Cycle Stand, and Teaching-Learning Atmosphere positively. Students rated the availability of internet facility, common room, canteen, and lavatory/toilet as moderate to inadequate.

An analysis of parents' feedback reveals positive responses (Good) regarding issues such as Admission Procedure, Infrastructure and Lab Facility, Student's Counseling and Guidance, Teaching Related Activities in the College, Examination Pattern Adopted by The University/College, and Scope of Access to the Authority in case of any query, with over 60% of parents responding positively.

The Teachers' Feedback report shows that teachers were granted autonomy by the college administration to implement innovative teaching methods such group discussions, seminar presentations, and student participation, as well as innovative evaluation approaches for students.

- 4. For uninterrupted internet services on college campus to ensure better delivery of education, IQAC proposed to enhance the speed limit of internet service from 20mbps to 30mbps.
- 5. Based on the feedback collected from different stakeholders of our college IQAC proposed to make the canteen more spacious to accommodate large number of teachers and students at a time. Wash room especially for Girls 'should be renovated. Members also suggested to increase the remedial coaching for the slow learners.
